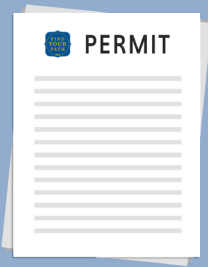


RESPECT PHILLY'S PARKS

DO:



RESERVE A SPOT

- Picnic permits are required for groups over 50 people.
- To reserve a picnic site, the cost is as low as \$35.

CARRY OUT WHAT YOU CARRY IN

- Dispose of your trash in the appropriate container.
- If you are hosting a larger group, please bring your own heavy duty trash bags and be sure to leave the picnic area clean for the next park users.
- If you barbecue, dispose of coals properly. Please do not dump hot coals on lawn areas.
