5. Proof of financial need (your family's IRS 2009 Form 1040, 1040A or 1040EZ, your post-secondary school financial aid award letter, 2010 FAFSA and/or other proof of income/financial need). (**This applies to ALL applicants**)
6. A resume which includes your high school activities, school and community volunteer experiences, work experiences, career goals, and references. (**This applies to ALL applicants**). Additionally, re-applicants should include their college activities, volunteer and/or work experiences, internships, etc. The resume must be typed.
7. A signed copy of the Cedar Park Neighbors Scholarship Support Statement (attached to this application).
